Viticulture and Vinification

- 100% estate grown and hand harvested.
- Vinified in the méthode traditionnelle style and 100% cuvée, first press.
- Manual thinning is practiced in the vineyard, which reduces the crop yield and produces a more concentrated and higher quality grape.
- Grapes are all whole cluster pressed and each variety is fermented separately.
- After the first fermentation the wines were blended and re-inoculated with yeast and bottled in Spring 2011.
- Secondary fermentation occurs in the bottle and wine was then left to age sur-lie for 6 1/2 years.
- The wine was disgorged in Fall 2017 and finished in the classic brut style.
- Lastly the wine is left for approximately 12 months prior to release.

Winemaker Notes

The Reserve Brut 2010 has a fine mousse, with fresh complex aroma of red fruit/citrus and toasty character on the nose and across the palate with a long rich strawberry finish. The wine is made in the méthode traditionnelle style.
